These three charming crochet cats, each with their own unique color and personality, are great for beginners and experienced crocheters alike.



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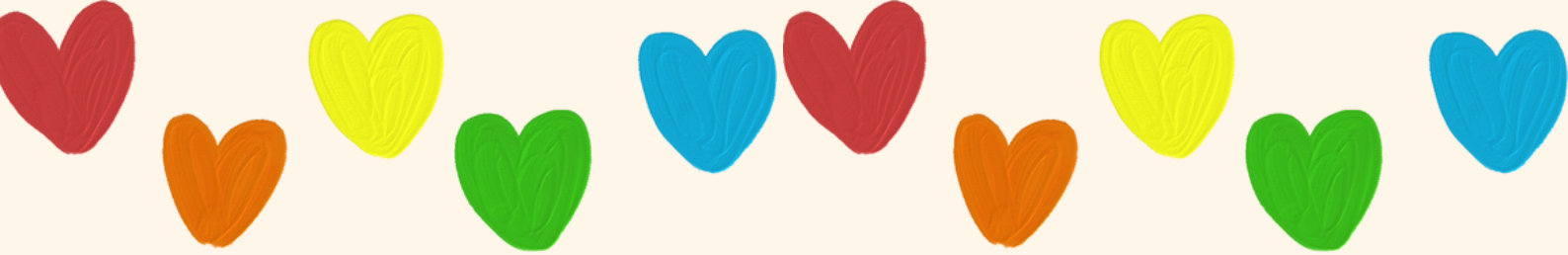
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Cat Crochet Pattern

Materials You'll Need

Hooks: Crochet hook that is convenient for you when using such kind of yarn. I used C / 2.5 mm and B / 2.0 mm hook.

Yarn weight: 2 Sport (1.76oz / 50g, 131yds / 120m)

Amount of yarn needed: 10 grams

4mm plastic eyes

Stuffing

Stitch marker

Sewing needle

Abbreviations

MR = Magic Ring

Rnd = Round

SC = Single Crochet

HDC = Half Double Crochet

DC = Double Crochet

INC = Increase (2 Single Crochets in the same stitch)

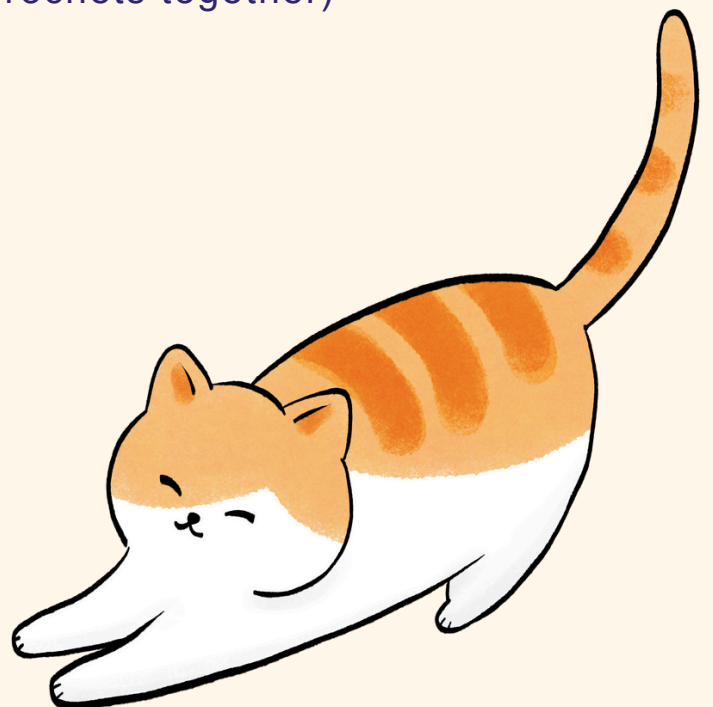
DEC= Decrease SC (Crochet 2 Single Crochets together)

CH = Chain

ST / STS = Stitch / Stitches

SL ST = Slip Stitch

FO = Fasten Off



Ear (make 2)

Use white yarn, I used 2.0 mm/ US B hook

Rnd 1: 6 SC in magic ring [6]

Rnd 2: (2 SC, INC) x2 [8]

Rnd 3: (3 SC, INC) x2 [10]

Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing.



Head

Use white yarn, I used 2.5 mm/ US C hook

Ch 8. Stitches are worked around both sides of the foundation chain.

Rnd 1: Start in second chain from the hook, 6 SC, 3 SC in the same stitch, Continue on the other side of the foundation chain, 5 SC, INC in the last stitch. [16]

Rnd 2: INC, 5 SC, 3 INC, 5 SC, 2 INC [22]

Rnd 3: SC, INC, 5 SC, (SC, INC)*3, 5 SC, (SC, INC)*2 [28]

Rnd 4: SC, INC, 6 SC, (SC, INC, SC)*3, 5 SC, (SC, INC, SC)*2 [34]

Rnd 5: 34 SC [34]

We will use both white yarn and brown yarn for the following rounds.

Rnd 6: 22 SC, **4 SC**, 8 SC [34]

Rnd 7: 21 SC, **6 SC**, 7 SC [34]

Rnd 8: SC, DEC, 9 SC, DEC, 4 SC, DEC, 2 SC, **4 SC**, 3 SC, DEC, 3 SC [30]

Use white yarn

Rnd 9: DEC, 9 SC, 3 DEC, 9 SC, 2 DEC [24]

Rnd 10: 24 SC [24]

Rnd 11: (2 SC, DEC) x6 [18]

Rnd 12: (SC, DEC) x6 [12]

Rnd 13: (SC, DEC) x4 [8]

Stuff the head firmly.

Close the end of the round.

Assembly

Glue the eyes on round 7, 2 stitches apart.

Embroider the nose on round 7 with dark brown yarn.

Embroider the whiskers on round 7 with dark brown yarn, 6 stitches apart.

Ear (make 2)

Use yellow yarn, I used 2.0 mm/ US B hook

Rnd 1: 6 SC in magic ring [6]

Rnd 2: (2 SC, INC) x2 [8]

Rnd 3: (3 SC, INC) x2 [10]

Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing.



Head

Use yellow yarn, I used 2.5 mm/ US C hook

Ch 8. Stitches are worked around both sides of the foundation chain.

Rnd 1: Start in second chain from the hook, 6 SC, 3 SC in the same stitch, Continue on the other side of the foundation chain, 5 SC, INC in the last stitch. [16]

Rnd 2: INC, 5 SC, 3 INC, 5 SC, 2 INC [22]

We will use both yellow yarn and white yarn for the following rounds.

Rnd 3: SC, INC, 5 SC, (SC, INC)*3, **6 SC**, INC, SC, INC [28]

Rnd 4: SC, INC, 6 SC, (SC, INC, SC)*2, SC, INC, **7 SC, INC**, 2 SC, INC, SC [34]

Rnd 5: 21 SC, **7 SC**, 6 SC [34]

Rnd 6: 22 SC, **5 SC**, 7 SC [34]

Rnd 7: 23 SC, **3 SC**, 8 SC [34]

Rnd 8: SC, DEC, 9 SC, DEC, 4 SC, DEC, 4 SC, **SC**, 4 SC, DEC, 3 SC [30]

Use yellow yarn

Rnd 9: DEC, 9 SC, 3 DEC, 9 SC, 2 DEC [24]

Rnd 10: 24 SC [24]

Rnd 11: (2 SC, DEC) x6 [18]

Rnd 12: (SC, DEC) x6 [12]

Rnd 13: (SC, DEC) x4 [8]

Stuff the head firmly.

Close the end of the round.

Assembly

Glue the eyes on round 8, 4 stitches apart.

Embroider the nose on round 7 with dark brown yarn.

Embroider the whiskers on round 6 with dark brown yarn, 6 stitches apart.

Ear (make 2)

Use brown yarn, I used 2.0 mm/ US B hook

Rnd 1: 6 SC in magic ring [6]

Rnd 2: (2 SC, INC) x2 [8]

Rnd 3: (3 SC, INC) x2 [10]

Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing.

Head

Use white yarn, I used 2.5 mm/ US C hook

Ch 8. Stitches are worked around both sides of the foundation chain.

Rnd 1: Start in second chain from the hook, 6 SC, 3 SC in the same stitch, Continue on the other side of the foundation chain, 5 SC, INC in the last stitch. [16]

Rnd 2: INC, 5 SC, 3 INC, 5 SC, 2 INC [22]

Rnd 3: SC, INC, 5 SC, (SC, INC)*3, 5 SC, (SC, INC)*2 [28]

Rnd 4: SC, INC, 7 SC, INC, 2 SC, INC, 2 SC, INC, 7 SC, INC, 2 SC, INC, SC [34]

Rnd 5-6: 34 SC [34], 2 rounds

We will use both white yarn and brown yarn for the following rounds.

Rnd 7: **20 SC**, 8 SC, **6 SC** [34]

Rnd 8: **SC, DEC, 9 SC, DEC, 4 SC, DEC, SC, 6 SC, 2 SC, DEC, 3 SC** [30]

Rnd 9: **DEC, 9 SC, 3 DEC, 2 SC**, 4 SC, **3 SC, 2 DEC** [24]

Rnd 10: **16 SC**, 2 SC, **6 SC** [24]

Rnd 11: **(DEC, 2 SC) x4**, DEC, **2 SC, DEC, 2 SC** [18]

Use brown yarn

Rnd 12: **(SC, DEC) x6** [12]

Rnd 13: **(SC, DEC) x4** [8]

Stuff the head firmly.

Tips: To close the end of the round: With yarn needle, insert the remaining yarn through all the front loops of the stitches of the last round. Pull them all together at once and sew to hide the yarn inside the part you are working on.

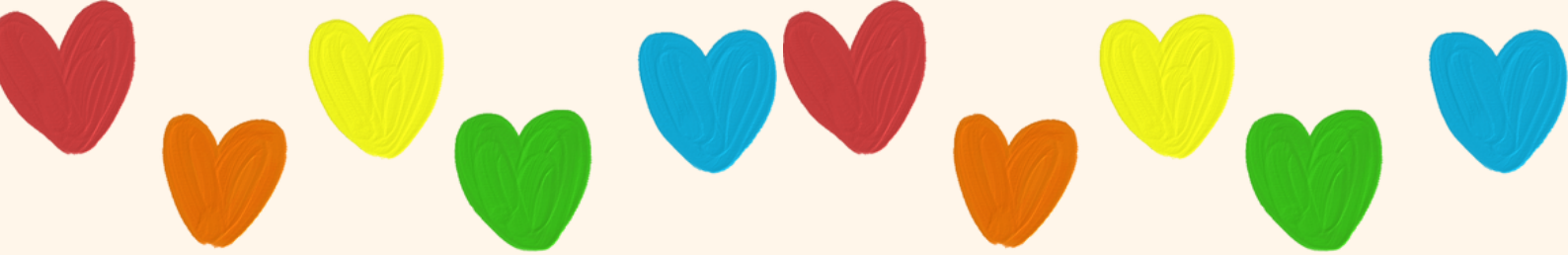
