

Lily of the Valley Coaster – Free Crochet Pattern

Abbreviations

MR = Magic Ring

Rnd = Round

SC = Single Crochet

HDC = Half Double Crochet

DC = Double Crochet

DC INC = Increase Double Crochet

(2 Double Crochets in the same stitch)

Cluster = 3 Incomplete Half Double Crochet


CH = Chain

ST / STS = Stitch / Stitches

SL ST = Slip Stitch

SK = Skip

FO = Fasten Off



This crochet coaster pattern features a round blue base with two white lily of the valley flowers and two green leaves. Using a sport weight cotton yarn and a 2.5mm crochet hook, you can create a beautiful, functional piece of décor for your home. The flowers add a touch of nature, while the coaster serves a practical purpose, protecting surfaces from hot cups or mugs.

Coaster

Use blue yarn

Rnd 1: 14 DC in magic ring [14]

Rnd 2: 14 DC INC [28]

Rnd 3: (DC, DC INC) x14 [42]

Rnd 4: (2 DC, DC INC) x14 [56]

Rnd 5: (3 DC, DC INC) x14 [70]

Rnd 7: (SC, SK 1, [5 DC in same stitch], SK 2) x14 [84]

Fasten off

Lily of the valley (make 2)

Use white yarn

Rnd 1: 6 SC in magic ring [6]

Rnd 2: 6 INC [12]

Rnd 3 - 4: 12 SC [12]

Rnd 5: *[Ch 2, Cluster, Ch 2] in the same stitch, SL ST*, repeat between *'s 6 times

Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing.



Big leaf

Use green yarn

Ch 11, start in second chain from the hook: SL ST, SC, 2 HDC, 3 DC, 2 HDC, SC.

Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Small leaf

Use green yarn

Ch 8, start in second chain from the hook: SL ST, SC, HDC, 2 DC, HDC, SC.

Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing.
