– Free Crochet Pattern

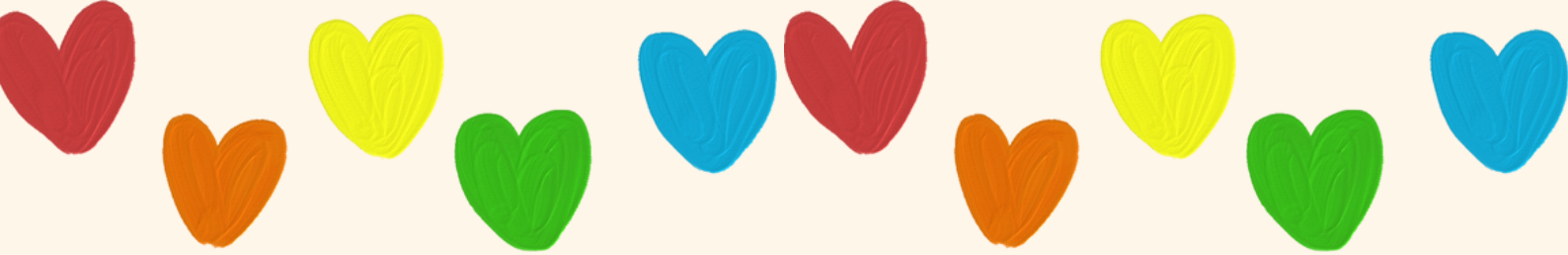

Abbreviations (US Terms)

MR = Magic Ring

Rnd = Round

SC = Single Crochet

DC = Double Crochet

INC = Increase (2 Single Crochets in the same stitch)

DEC= Decrease SC (Crochet 2 Single Crochets together)

TR = Treble Crochet

P = Picot (Ch 3, insert hook into front loop of the third chain from the hook, yarn over, pull through all loops on hook.)

CH = Chain

ST / STS = Stitch / Stitches

SL ST = Slip Stitch

FO = Fasten Off

Egg Body

Rnd 1: 6 SC in magic ring [6]

Rnd 2: 6 INC [12]

Rnd 3: (3 SC, INC) x3 [15]

Rnd 4: (2 SC, INC, 2 SC) x3 [18]

Rnd 5: (5 SC, INC) x3 [21]

Rnd 6: (3 SC, INC, 3 SC) x3 [24]

Rnd 7: (7 SC, INC) x3 [27]

Rnd 8: (4 SC, INC, 4 SC) x3 [30]

Rnd 9-11: 30 SC [30], 3 rounds

Rnd12: (13 SC, DEC) x2 [28]

Rnd13: (5 SC, DEC) x4 [24]

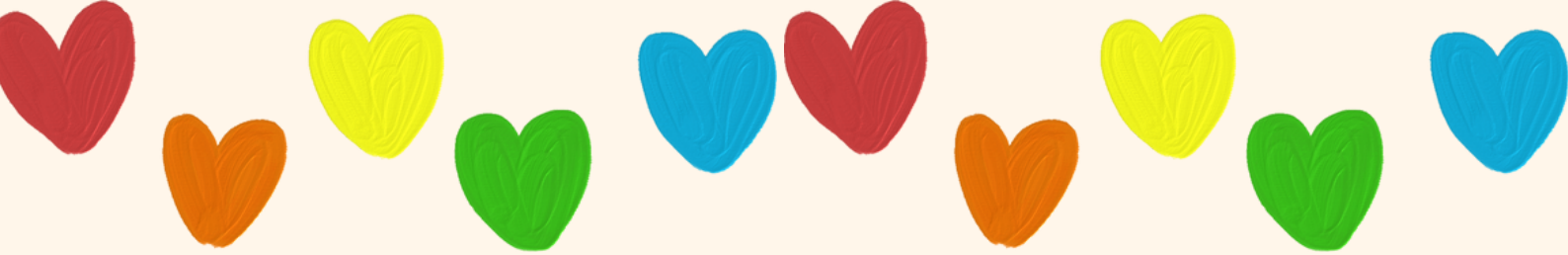
Rnd 14: (2 SC, DEC, 2 SC) x4 [20]

Rnd 15: (3 SC, DEC) x4 [16]

Rnd 16: SC, DEC, (2 SC, DEC) x3, SC [9]

Tip: Stuff the egg firmly before you close it to keep a nice, rounded shape.

Fasten off and weave in ends.



How to Decorate Crochet Easter Eggs

Once your egg shape is ready, it's time to decorate!

Here are some ideas for personalizing your crochet Easter eggs:

- Crocheted Flowers: Tiny floral motifs make a charming addition.
- Embroidery: Add little stems, leaves, or polka dots with embroidery thread.
- Ribbons and Lace: Tie a bow or add a small lace accent for extra sweetness.
- Beads and Sequins: Sew on tiny embellishments for a sparkling effect.

This is a wonderful opportunity to get creative and use up all those little scraps of yarn you've been saving!
