

Blueberry Pillow

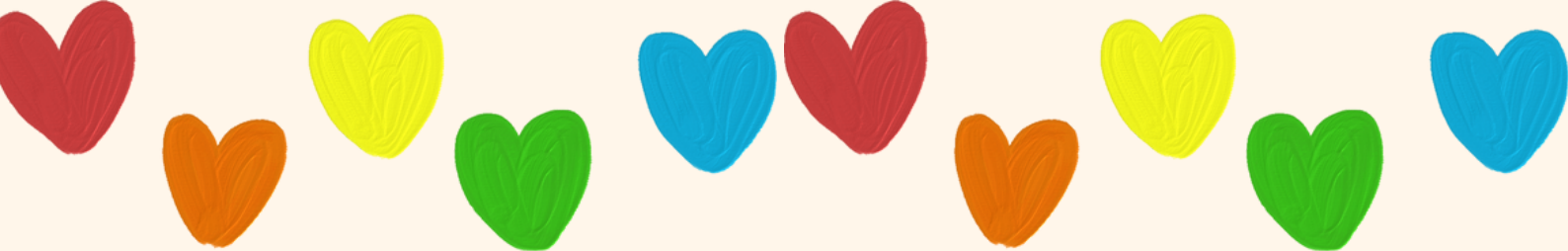
– Free Crochet Pattern

Soft, round, and full of personality, this blueberry pillow is as squishy as it is adorable. It's part of our Fruit Pillow Crochet Kit, which also includes a strawberry, dragon fruit, and green apple pillow—perfect for crochet lovers of all levels. Whether you're decorating a cozy corner or gifting a handmade plushie, this free crochet pattern is sure to brighten your space.



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Abbreviations (US Terms)

MR = Magic Ring

Rnd = Round

Ch = Chain

SC = Single Crochet

HDC = Half Double Crochet

DC = Double Crochet

INC = Increase (2 Single Crochets in the same stitch)

HDC INC = Increase (2 Half Double Crochets in the same stitch)

DC INC = Increase (2 Double Crochets in the same stitch)

Picot = Ch 1, Slst in first chain.

Slst = Slip Stitch

BLO = Back Loops Only

St = Stitch

Tip: Ch(s) are not counted as a stitch unless otherwise stated.

Materials:

- Yarn: PuffyCloud Chenille Yarn
 - Color: 03 Blueberry (body, 2 skeins), 16 Moss (leaves, 1 skein), pink (blush), black (eyes & mouth), white (highlights)
- Yarn weight: Super Bulky #6 (10.6 oz / 300g, 176yds / 160m)
- Hook sizes: 7.0 mm and 2.5 mm
- Stuffing, sewing needle, stitch marker

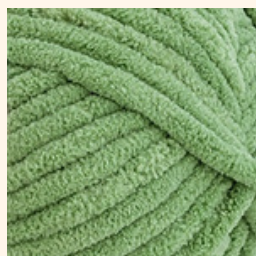

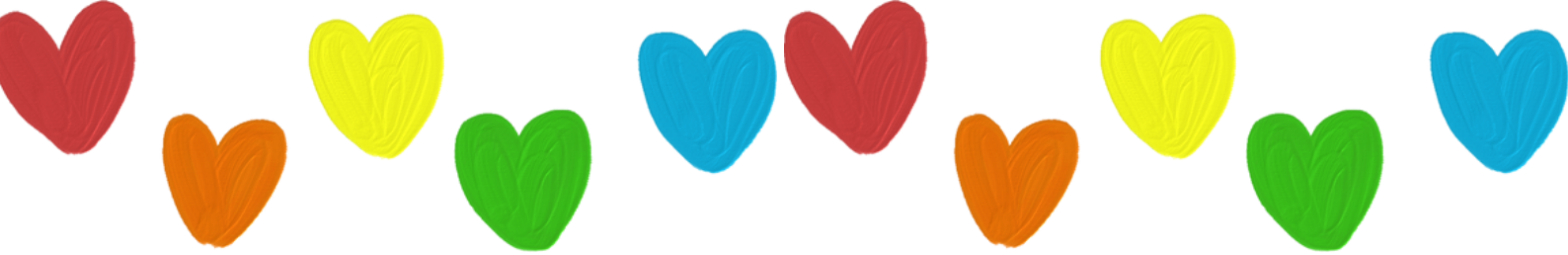
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Blueberry

Use 03 Blueberry yarn. 7.0 mm crochet hook. **Add stuffing while crocheting.**

Rnd 1: 7 SC in magic ring [7]

Rnd 2: 7 INC [14]

Rnd 3: (INC, SC) x7 [21]

Rnd 4: (SC, INC, SC) x7 [28]

Rnd 5: (3 SC, INC) x7 [35]

Rnd 6: 35 Slst [35]

Rnd 7: Work in the back loops of round 6.

Ch in the first stitch

HDC in the second stitch

HDC and Ch in the third stitch

Slst and Ch in the fourth stitch

Repeat *HDC, HDC and Ch, Slst and Ch* until the end of the round.

Now we finished the Star-shaped scar of the blueberry.





Blueberry

Rnd 8: Work in the two loops of round 5: (2 SC, INC, 2 SC) x7 [42]

Rnd 9: (5 SC, INC) x7 [49]

Rnd 10: (3 SC, INC, 3 SC) x7 [56]

Rnd 11: (7 SC, INC) x7 [63]

Rnd 12: (4 SC, INC, 4 SC) x7 [70]

Rnd 13: (9 SC, INC) x7 [77]

Rnd 14: (5 SC, INC, 5 SC) x7 [84]

Rnd 15-22: 84 SC [84], 8 rounds

Rnd 23: (5 SC, DEC, 5 SC) x7 [77]

Rnd 24: (9 SC, DEC) x7 [70]

Rnd 25: (4 SC, DEC, 4 SC) x7 [63]

Rnd 26: (7 SC, DEC) x7 [56]

Rnd 27: (3 SC, DEC, 3 SC) x7 [49]

Rnd 28: (5 SC, DEC) x7 [42]

Rnd 29: (2 SC, DEC, 2 SC) x7 [35]

Rnd 30: (3 SC, DEC) x7 [28]

Rnd 31: (SC, DEC, SC) x7 [21]

Rnd 32: (SC, DEC) x7 [14]

Rnd 33: 7 DEC [7]

Close the opening and fasten off.



Tips: To close the end of the round: With yarn needle, insert the remaining yarn through all the front loops of the stitches of the last round. Pull them all together at once and sew to hide the yarn inside the part you are working on.





Leaf (make 3)

Use 16 Moss yarn. 7.0 mm crochet hook.

Ch 10. Stitches are worked around both sides of the foundation chain.

Rnd 1: Start in second chain from the hook, SC, 2 HDC, 3 DC, 2 HDC, 3 SC in the same stitch. Continue on the other side of the foundation chain, 2 HDC, 3 DC, 2 HDC, INC in the last stitch. [20]

Rnd 2: INC, 2 SC, INC, SC, INC, 2 SC, INC, [SC, 2 Ch, SC in same stitch], INC, 2 SC, INC, SC, INC, 2 SC, 2 INC. [30]

Rnd 3: 14 SC, In the Ch-2 space work [SC, 1 Picot, SC], 16 SC.

Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Blush (make 2)

Use pink yarn. 2.5 mm crochet hook.

Rnd 1: 7 SC in magic ring [7]

Rnd 2: 7 INC [14]

Rnd 3: (INC, SC) x7 [21]

Rnd 4: (SC, INC, SC) x7 [28]

Rnd 5: (3 SC, INC) x7 [35]

Rnd 6: (2 SC, INC, 2 SC) x7 [42]

Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing.



Eye (make 2)

Use black yarn. 2.5 mm crochet hook.

Ch 4. Stitches are worked around both sides of the foundation chain.

Rnd 1: Start in second chain from the hook, 2 SC, 3 SC in the same stitch. Continue on the other side of the foundation chain, SC, INC in the last stitch. Slst to the first stitch. [8]

Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Mouth

Use black yarn. 2.5 mm crochet hook. Ch 11.

Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail for sewing.



Assembly

Sew the eyes on to the blueberry at Round 18, 4 sts apart.

Sew the mouth onto the blueberry at Round 19.

Sew the blushes onto the blueberry between Rounds 19-22, 6 sts apart.

Sew the leaves to the bottom of the blueberry.
